Flood-Impacted Families May Qualify for Up to \$300,000 — Free Workshop in Tuolumne County

Program offers forgivable loans to help Californians affected by the 2023 floods buy safer homes

Tuolumne County, CA, September 22, 2025 – Golden State Finance Authority (GSFA) invites Tuolumne County residents impacted by the 2023 floods to attend a free Homebuyer Workshop on Tuesday, October 7, 2025, from 7:00 – 8:00 p.m. at the Tuolumne County Administration, Board Chambers.

The workshop will introduce the ReCoverCA Homebuyer Assistance (HBA) Program which provides up to \$300,000 in forgivable loan assistance to eligible renters and former homeowners impacted by the 2023 floods in Tuolumne County. The program is designed to help households purchase a home in California outside of special flood hazard and high fire zone areas.

Attendees will learn about:

- How the ReCoverCA HBA Program works
- Eligibility requirements
- Qualifying property types
- Steps to get started

The event also offers an optional networking session with GSFA representatives and approved ReCoverCA HBA Lenders, giving participants the opportunity to ask questions, gather resources, and set up follow-up appointments for personalized support.
